*Confession of Faith

Westminster Shorter Catechism 14-16

- Q. 17. Into what estate did the fall bring mankind?
- A. The fall brought mankind into an estate of sin and misery.
- Q. 18. Wherein consists the sinfulness of that estate where into man fell?
- A. The sinfulness of that estate where into man fell, consists in the guilt of Adam's first sin, the want of original righteousness, and the corruption of his whole nature, which is commonly called original sin; together with all actual transgressions which proceed for it.
- Q. 19. What is the misery of that estate where into man fell?
- A. All mankind by their fall lost communion with God, are under his wrath and curse, and so made liable to all the miseries of this life, to death itself, and to the pains of hell forever.

The Westminster Shorter Catechism expresses the truths of the Bible in summary form. It was comprised at the Westminster Assembly in London (1643-1648), and it sets forth the doctrinal standards of our church and our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America.
