Children's Catechism 1-13

- 1. Q. Who made you?
 - A. God.
- 2. Q. What else did God make?
 - A. God made all things.
- 3. Q. Why did God make you and all things?
 - A. For his own glory.
- 4. Q. How can you glorify God?
 - A. By loving him and doing what he commands.
- 5. Q. Why are you to glorify God?
 - A. Because he made me and takes care of me.
- 6. Q. Is there more than one true God?
 - A. No. There is only one true God.
- 7. Q. In how many Persons does this one God exist?
 - A. In three Persons.
- 8. Q. Name these three persons.
 - A. The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- 9. Q. What is God?
 - A. God is a Spirit and does not have a body like men.
- 10. Q. Where is God?
 - A. God is everywhere.
- 11. Q. Can you see God?
 - A. No. I cannot see God, but he always sees me.
- 12. Q. Does God know all things?
 - A. Yes. Nothing can be hidden from God.
- 13. Q. Can God do all things?
 - A. Yes. God can do all his holy will.
