The Events of the Last Day

On Sunday, July 9th we studied 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18, where Paul lays out the order of events (bold print below) of the Last Day. Last week we studied Revelation 20, where John gives us more information about the events leading up to the 2nd Coming and about the final judgment (regular print below).

From Rev 20, we learned that we are currently living in the "millennial reign" of Jesus Christ, which began at his 1st Coming and will conclude just before his 2nd Coming. During this period, Satan is "bound" (i.e. he is kept from deceiving the nations) so that the church, by God's grace, may fulfill the Great Commission by making disciples of all nations. At the end of the "millennial reign", Satan will be set free for a short time.
