Westminster Confession of Faith, Section 8.4

Pastor:

Christian, what do you believe about our Lord Jesus Christ,

the only Mediator between God and man?

People: We believe that Jesus Christ

most willingly undertook the office of Mediator, and in order to discharge its obligations,

he was born under the law, and perfectly fulfilled it.

He endured most grievous torments in his soul and most painful sufferings in his body;

He was crucified, died, and was buried;

He remained under the power of death, yet his body did not undergo decay:

And he arose from the dead on the third day with the same body in which he had suffered.

In this body he ascended into heaven,

where he sits at the right hand of his Father, making intercession,

and he shall return to judge men and angels at the end of the age. Amen.

The Westminster Confession of Faith expresses the teachings of the Bible in summary form. It was comprised at the Westminster Assembly in London (1643-1648), and it sets forth the doctrinal standards of our church and our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America.
