*Confession of Faith

Westminster Confession of Faith, Section 8.2

Q. Christian, what do you believe about Jesus Christ and the Incarnation?

A. We believe that the Son of God,

the second person in the Trinity, being truly and eternally God, of one substance and equal with the Father, did, when the fullness of time had come, take upon himself man's nature, with all its essential properties and common infirmities, yet without sin.

He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit in the womb of the virgin Mary and of her substance.

In this way, two whole natures, the divine and the human, perfect and distinct, were inseparably joined together in one person without being changed, mixed, or confused.

This person is truly God and truly man, yet one Christ, the only mediator between God and man. Amen.

The Westminster Confession of Faith expresses the teachings of the Bible in summary form. It was comprised at the Westminster Assembly in London (1643-1648), and it sets forth the doctrinal standards of our church and our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America.
