Westminster Larger Catechism 80 & 81

Can true believers be rightly confident that they are in the state of grace

and that they will persevere in it until their salvation?

People: Those who truly believe in Christ,

and who endeavor to walk in all good conscience before him, may be rightly confident that they are in the state of grace and that they will persevere in that state until their salvation.

They can know this without extraordinary revelation, by faith grounded on the truth of God's promises and by the Spirit enabling them to discern in themselves those graces to which the promises of life are made,

bearing witness with their spirits that they are the children of God.

Pastor: Are all true believers at all times confident of their being in the state of

grace and that they will be saved?

People: Because confidence of grace and salvation are not the essence of faith,

true believers may wait a long time before they obtain it,

and after the enjoyment of it

they may have it weakened and discontinued

through many types of disorders, sins, temptations,

and times of feeling deserted by God.

Yet they are never left without such presence and support

of the Spirit of God as keeps them from sinking into utter despair.

The Westminster Confession of Faith expresses the teachings of the Bible in summary form. It was comprised at the Westminster Assembly in London (1643-1648), and it sets forth the doctrinal standards of North Macon Presbyterian Church and our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America.

Title: Assurance of Salvation Text: 1 John 3:11-24

And those he predestined, he also called; those he called, he also justified; those he justified, he also glorified.

Belgic Confession, Article 16: The Doctrine of Election

We believe that—all Adam's descendants, having thus fallen into damnation and ruin by the sin of Adam—God showed Himself to be as He is: merciful and just.

God is merciful in delivering and saving from this damnation those who, in the eternal and unchangeable divine counsel, have been elected and chosen in Jesus Christ our Lord, by His pure goodness, without any consideration of their works.

God is just in leaving the others in their ruin and damnation into which they plunged themselves.

WSC Q. 31. What is effectual calling?

Effectual calling is the work of God's Spirit, whereby, convincing us of our sin and misery, enlightening our minds in the knowledge of Christ, and renewing our wills,

He doth persuade and enable us to embrace Jesus Christ, freely offered in the gospel.

WSC Q. 87. What is repentance unto life?

Repentance unto life is a saving grace, whereby a sinner, out of a true sense of his sin, and apprehension of the mercy of God in Christ, does, with grief and hatred of his sin, turn from it unto God, with full purpose of, and endeavor after, new obedience.

WSC Q. 86. What is faith in Jesus Christ?

Faith in Jesus Christ is a saving grace, whereby we receive and rest upon Him alone for salvation, as He is offered to us in the gospel.

WSC Q. 33. What is justification?

Justification is an act of God's free grace, wherein He pardons all our sins, and accepts us as righteous in His sight, only for the righteousness of Christ imputed to us, and received by faith alone.

WSC Q. 34. What is adoption?

Adoption is an act of God's free grace, whereby we are received into the number, and have a right to all the privileges of the sons of God.

WSC Q. 35. What is sanctification?

Sanctification is the work of God's free grace, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness.

WSC Q. 36. What are the benefits which in this life do accompany or flow from justification, adoption, and sanctification?

The benefits which in this life do accompany or flow from justification, adoption, and sanctification, are, assurance of God's love, peace of conscience, joy in the Holy Spirit, increase of grace, and perseverance therein to the end.

WSC Q. 37. What benefits do believers receive from Christ at death?

The souls of believers are at their death made perfect in holiness, and do immediately pass into glory; and their bodies, being still united to Christ, do rest in their graves till the resurrection.

WSC Q. 38. What benefits to believers receive from Christ at the resurrection?

At the resurrection, believers being raised up in glory, shall be openly acknowledged and acquitted in the day of judgment, and made perfectly blessed in the full enjoying of God to all eternity.
