Westminster Confession of Faith, Sections 1.2, 7, 9

Pastor: Christian, what do you believe about the Scriptures?

People: Under the name of Holy Scripture, or the written Word of God,

are all the books of the Old and New Testaments.

All these are given by inspiration of God to be the rule of faith and life.

Not all things in Scripture are equally plain in themselves or equally clear to all; yet those things which are necessary to be known, believed, and observed for salvation are so clearly stated and explained in one place or another in Scripture, that not only the educated but also the uneducated may gain a sufficient understanding of them by a proper use of the ordinary means.

The infallible rule of interpretation of Scripture is the Scripture itself.

Therefore, when there is a question about the true and full meaning of any Scripture (which is not manifold, but one), that meaning must be searched out and ascertained by other places that speak more clearly. Amen.

The Westminster Confession of Faith expresses the teachings of the Bible in summary form. It was comprised at the Westminster Assembly in London (1643-1648), and it sets forth the doctrinal standards of our church and our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America.
