- Q. 85. Christian, with death being the wages of sin, why are not the rightcous delivered from death, seeing that all their sins are forgiven in Christ?
- A. The rightcous shall be delivered from death itself at the last day, and even in death are delivered from the sting and curse of it; so that, although they die, yet it is out of God's love, to free them perfectly from sin and misery, and to make them capable of further communion with Christ in glory, which they then enter upon.
