*Confession of Faith

Westminster Shorter Catechism, Questions 1, 4, 5 & 6

- Q. Christian, what is the chief end of man?
- A. Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever.
- Q. What is God?
- A. God is a Spirit,
 infinite, eternal, and unchangeable,
 in his being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth.
- Q. Are there more God's than one?
- A. There is but one only, the living and true God.
- Q. How many persons are in the Godhead?
- A. There are three persons in the Godhead:
 the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost,
 and these three are one God,
 the same in substance, equal in power and glory. Amen.

The Westminster Shorter Catechism expresses the teachings of the Bible in summary form. It was comprised at the Westminster Assembly in London (1643-1648), and it sets forth the doctrinal standards of our church and our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America.

The Trinity in Scripture Selected Scriptures

Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. But John tried to deter him, saying, I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me? Jesus replied, Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness. Then John consented. As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased" (Matthew 3:13-17).

Only 1 God:

- Deut 6:4 Hear, O Israel: The LORD is our God, the LORD is one.
- Deut 32:39 See now that I myself am He! There is no god besides me. I put to death and I bring to life, I have wounded and I will heal, and no one can deliver out of my hand.
- Is 46:9-10 Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me. I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come.
- OT Hints: Gen 1:26. Elohim. The Angel of the LORD. The Messiah.

3 Distinct Persons in the Godhead:

Jesus' baptism. The outpouring of the Spirit. The Great Commission. Revelation 1:4-5.

1 Peter 1:1-2 To God's elect, strangers in the world... who have been chosen according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through the sanctifying work of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Christ and sprinkling by his blood.

Same in substance, equal in power and glory:

Each is called God, share the attributes of God, acts as God, and is worshipped as God,

- Gen 1:1-2 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ...and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.
- John 1:1-3 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through him all things were made; with him nothing was made that has been made. In him was life, and that life was the light of men.
- John 5:26 For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself.
- John 6:63 The Spirit gives life; the flesh counts for nothing.
- Acts 5:3-4 Then Peter said, "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit...You have not lied to men but to God."
- Hebrews 9:14 How much more, then, will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!
