Apostles' Creed

*Confession of Faith

Pastor: Christian, what do you believe?

ALL: I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth.

And in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; he descended into hell*; the third day he rose again from the dead. Christ's humiliation after his death consisted in his being buried and continuing in the state of the dead and under the power of death until the third day, which has also been expressed in these words: "He descended into hell."

The Apostles' Creed was not written by the apostles but is a summary of their teachings. It dates back to the 4th century and has been used by the church to identify believers, instruct new converts, and provide a confession of faith for worship.
