Westminster Confession of Faith, Chapter 2.1

Pastor: Christian, what do you believe about God?

We believe there is only one true and living God, who is infinite in being and perfection.
He is a most pure spirit, invisible, with neither body, parts, nor passive properties.
He is unchangeable, boundless, eternal, and incomprehensible.
He is almighty, most wise, most holy, most free, and most absolute.
He works all things according to the counsel of his own unchangeable and most rightcous will, for his own glory.
He is most loving, gracious, merciful, long-suffering, abundant in goodness and truth, forgiving iniquity, transgression, and sin, and he is the rewarder of those who diligently seek him.
He is also most just and terrifying in his judgments, hating all sin, and will by no means acquit the guilty. Amen.

The Westminster Confession of Faith expresses the teachings of the Bible in summary form. It was comprised at the Westminster Assembly in London (1643-1648), and it sets forth the doctrinal standards of our church and our denomination, the Presbyterian Church in America.
